This is what we support:

Animals of any breed/mix are capable of being trained to be of service. Requirements for PTSD and comfort dogs include • minimum of 1 year old • like being very close to handler • can do basic sit or down with stay • not a jumper or barker • comfortable in various environments • not reactionary to people and other dogs • willing to please handler • willing to work for anyone • not thunderphobic.

This is what we know:

When you are out with your dog, a letter from your physician is needed. You will not have to tell what your disability is, but you can expect to have to say what your dog does for you.

This is what we are going to do:

We will require a video demonstrating the above behavior requirements.
We will require proof that you have your doctor's letter.
